- A. A student is considered to be making unsatisfactory academic progress and will be placed on academic probation when his/her cumulative grade point average falls below 2.0.
- B. A student on academic probation for one semester will be required to consult with an Enrollment Manager before registering for another semester.
- C. During this conference, the Enrollment Manager and student will determine that one of the following actions is required:
 - 1. Continue with normal academic load next semester;
 - 2. Reduce academic load next semester;
 - 3. Either 1 or 2 above and participate in academic assistance in the form of tutoring, counseling sessions, learning lab or other appropriate resources;
 - 4. Enroll in preparatory courses of study; or
 - 5. Transfer to another program of study.
- D. If a student is on academic probation for two consecutive semesters, the student will be placed on academic suspension for the next semester and, prior to readmission, must meet with the Dean of Enrollment Management or designee. In lieu of academic suspension, the President may, at his/her discretion, institute other consequences that the President deems more appropriate for the specific situation.
