For core verification for transfer all grades in core courses must be C or better and overall GPA of 2.0 or higher. AS degree requires 2.0 GPA or higher. For each requirement enter the appropriate prefix, course number, and grade/hours for the class meeting that requirement. Example: HIS 122 – A/3. For students with transfer credit from NC community colleges, NC state schools, NC private schools who have signed the ICAA (listed on page 3), or any regionally accredited school enter TR as the grade. Transfer grades do **not** count in the CVCC GPA. Only these TR classes and AP (College Board) are usable for certification of the core. A **maximum of 14 hours** in the core is allowable from schools not in the CAA/ICAA. Any class on transcript, including TR from any CAA/ICAA school, can be used for degree credit. Classes in **bold** are in the CVCC catalog.

NOTE: Only the specific course numbers listed here will meet general education (core) requirements; all other CAA transfer courses are pre-major/elective only.

CVCC no longer offers “pre-majors,” but awards the AA or AS. For majors in a specific area always check with your intended school(s) of transfer. In the AS program these courses should prepare you for these majors.

Biology BIO111 & 1 of BIO112, BIO120, or BIO130; CHM151-152; MAT171 (or higher); 1 of these sequences is recommended CHM251-252, PHY151-152, or PHY251-252

Chemistry/Chemistry Education COM231; CHM151-152 & CHM251-252; PHY251-252; MAT271-272; 3 hours of CIS or CSC
MAT273 and PSY150 are recommended

Engineering CHM151; PHY251-252; MAT271-272-273 and MAT285; 1 of CSC134, CSC136, or CSC151; 1 of CHM152, or DFT170, or EGR220; 1 of ECO251 or ECO252 is recommended
If CHM152 is not chosen, 4 additional hours of math, science, or computer science are require to meet the 14 hour elective rule.

Math PHY251-252; MAT175, MAT271, MAT272, & MAT273; 1 of MAT280 or MAT285; 1 of CSC120, CSC134, CSC136, or CSC151; 3 additional hours of general education humanities and 3 additional hours of general education social/behavioral science

Pharmacy There is no “official” guide for pharmacy, it is imperative that you check with the schools you intend to apply to make sure you meet their requirements particularly for foreign language requirements. The courses listed below should meet prerequisites for most schools of pharmacy.
