Ask at the Circulation Desk:

Ask at Reference:

Books, newspapers and magazines. Current newspapers, magazines and journals are located in the Library's leisure reading area (see guide on reverse).

Compute:

Computers with Internet access and Microsoft Office software are located in the Circulation Area and behind the Reference Collection.

Wireless Internet access is available throughout the Library.

Learn:

Staff can demonstrate the best methods to access the general and specialized information needed.

Receive instruction on how to access and use NC LIVE databases.

Join a Library tour to learn the locations of important resources.

Book Return:

The book return is located in the 2nd Floor CAD Building lobby by Seattle's Best Coffee.

Group Study Rooms:

Eight rooms are available for small group study. Three larger rooms are also available for large group study. Please check at the Circulation Desk to reserve a large group study room.

ILL (Inter-Library Loan):

Library Staff can assist you with borrowing books from other libraries. Ask at the Circulation Desk for more information.

Lost and Found:

The Library lost and found area is located behind the Circulation Desk. The main campus Lost and Found is located in the CVCC Switchboard Office (VSL 223).
