The complete name and date of birth of each dependent must be recorded on the Affidavit of Support (Attachment B) under item number two. This information is essential in completing the I-20.

In order to qualify for an I-20, a **single** student must document at least \$31,829.05 in available funding per year. Students with dependents must document additional funding. Tuition or book expenses are paid per semester. Living expenses are not paid to the college, but must be documented as available to qualify for an I-20.

Students should not expect to be able to support themselves through part-time employment while they study. For the first year the only employment available to F-1 students is on-campus employment and this is extremely limited at CVCC. After the first year, limited off-campus employment opportunities are available for some students. In general, international students are not allowed to work while they are pursuing their education.

**Inadequate financial support will result in failure to maintain F-1 student status and possible deportation from the U.S. Please be sure that your financial resources or those of your sponsor are readily available to meet your educational and living expenses throughout your studies.**
